This Agreement

This Acceptable Use Agreement (the “Agreement”) sets out the rules governing the use of our website(s) including but not limited to kwaScouting.com (the “Website”) and any domain owned by KWA Area and any content that you may submit to the Website (“Content”).

By using our Website, you agree to the rules set out in this Agreement / This acceptable use agreement applies to all users of, and visitors to, our site.

General restrictions

You must not use our Website in any way that causes, or may cause, damage to the Website or impairment of the availability or accessibility of the Website, or any of the areas of, or services on, the Website.

You must not use our Website:

- (a) in any way that is unlawful, illegal, fraudulent or harmful; or
- (b) in connection with any unlawful, illegal, fraudulent or harmful purpose or activity.
- (c) to communicate, display, or promote any personal agenda's that are not in accordance with BP&P.

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Licence

You grant to us a worldwide, irrevocable, non-exclusive, royalty-free licence to use, reproduce, publish, [adapt,translate] and distribute your Content [on and in relation to the Website / in any existing and future media].

You also grant to us the right to sub-license these rights[, and the right to bring an action for infringement of these rights].

Unlawful and illegal material

You must not use our Website to store, host, copy, distribute, display, publish, transmit or send Content that is illegal or unlawful, or that will or may infringe a third party's legal rights, or that could give rise to legal action whether against you or us or a third party (in each case in any jurisdiction and under any applicable law).

Graphic material

Content must not depict violence in an explicit, graphic or gratuitous manner.

Harmful software

You must not use the Website to promote or distribute any viruses, Trojans, worms, root kits, spyware, [adware] or any other harmful software, programs, routines, applications or technologies.

Factual accuracy

Content must not be untrue, false, inaccurate or misleading.

Marketing and spam

You must not [without our prior written permission] use our Website for any purposes related to marketing,

advertising, promotion, or the supply and/or sale of goods and/or services.

Content must not constitute spam.

Netiquette

Content must be appropriate, civil, tasteful and accord with generally accepted standards of etiquette and

behaviour on the internet as well as BP&P.

Content or communication must not be [grossly] offensive, deceptive, threatening, abusive, harassing, or

menacing, hateful, discriminatory or inflammatory.

Content should not cause annoyance, inconvenience or needless anxiety.

Hyperlinks

You must not link to any website or web page containing material that would, were it posted on the Website,

breach [the preceding terms of this Agreement]

Breaches of this Agreement

Users who have been found to be in breach of this policy shall be referred to the Area Commissioner subsequent action taken at the Commissioners discretion including but not limited to immediate revocation of Website Access, immediate removal of related Website Content, and Escalation of breaches to National Council, and when necessary contact lawful authorities within Canada or the United States.
